

HOW IT WORKS

1. Lock-in the site!

Define the study area and site boundary to understand scale, phasing, and time horizon of the project.



4. Get Together

Get together with the stakeholder(s), client(s), or internally within the team.



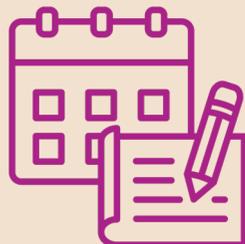
2. Analyze

Analyze the site context to understand the demographics, density, uses, and services.



3. Prep

Based on the analysis, print the site to a legible scale. Print the grid on transparent paper.



5. Let's Plug-in!

Make sure to filter out the relevant plug-ins based on the characteristics on the back of each card.

Make sure to flip the cards and record the findings!



6. Repeat as needed!
